

Local Scholarships

All scholarships will be based on the following criteria: Citizenship, Character, Need, Scholarship, Service, and an essay when required. Essays will be judged on the quality and originality of thought as well as the usual factors of spelling, punctuation, neatness, format, and following the directions.

You will receive an email from Mrs. Schulz, which will contain a link. Please click the link and enroll in course. Open your dashboard to gain access to the scholarship folder on Canvas. Each scholarship application will be set up as an "assignment" once you open the scholarship application it will automatically save on your drive where you can complete them and submit them online, and once submitted it will be logged with a date and time, just like a classroom assignment. If you do not have access to the internet at home, while at school, open the application, click on file, then click download as a MicroSoft Word document and this will automatically be saved to your desktop.

To be considered for any of the scholarships you must fully complete the application, according to the directions, and sign each Application if indicated.

The applicant must sign in every scholarship they applied for with the Guidance Office on or before 4:00 pm on the due date of March 13, 2018. You will sign and verify that your application(s) has been received.

All scholarship recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards, which will be held May 16, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.

AIRPRO FAN & BLOWER COMPANY

AirPro is offering an AirPro Jean Johnson Memorial Weld Training Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 for an area graduate to attend the Advanced Welding Institute (AWI). AWI will also be contributing to the scholarship in the amount of \$500, making the total award \$5,500.

ARTARAMA SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$1000 scholarships are available to seniors at Northland Pines, Phelps, and Three Lakes High School. This general scholarship must be used within the year it is presented. Applicants will be chosen based upon a combination of academics, extra-curricular and community involvement, letters of reference and personal interview.

ART PERTILE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is in memory of Art Pertile, high school guidance counselor. This \$1000 scholarship is open to any student pursuing a two or four year degree at an accredited institution. An essay of 500-1000 words is required.

ADVANCED WELDING INSTITUTE

Two \$500 scholarships are available to Three Lakes School District graduating students that are planning to attend the Advanced Welding Institute. One Scholarship is for a student graduating in January 2018 and one for a June, 2017 graduate. Consideration will be given to students with a passion for metal manufacturing/welding. This scholarship must be used one year from acceptance.

BMO HARRIS BANK

This \$500 scholarship is available to any student attending either a four-year university or two-year technical school to pursue a degree in business or technology.

CROSS COUNTRY'S PUSH TO BETTER THE COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

Cross Country Bar & Grill is providing one \$500 scholarship to an outstanding graduating student who desires to further his/her education beyond high school. Criteria for the selection process will be academic achievement, career goals, & extra-curricular activities. An essay of 150 words or more is required on "Why I would like to continue my Education". Current, and former employees not eligible to apply.

DAVID M. RASMUSSEN ENGINEERING

Available to those entering an engineering program preferably at UW-Madison, UW-Milwaukee or Milwaukee School of Engineering, however will consider other Wisconsin Schools. The value of the scholarship is \$750. A grade point average of 2.0 (on a scale of 4.0) or higher is required in the first semester to continue the scholarship for the second semester.

DOROTHY LOUISE STEIN

This scholarship is open to graduating seniors preferably studying a degree in science, technology, or engineering, or alternatively, in natural sciences and environment. Preference is given to those students attending UW-Madison, or another UW campus or Michigan Technological University. This scholarship is \$2,000 payable by semester.

DOUG KOSHUTA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - THREE LAKES FISH AND WILDLIFE IMPROVEMENT ASSN. INC.

This scholarship is in memory of Doug Koshuta, a founding board member of the Fish & Wildlife Association. The primary focus of this scholarship is to aid students in the field of Natural Resources and related Natural Resources studies. Applicants must be enrolled with an accredited institution of higher education and in good academic standing.

DON BURNSIDE MEMORIAL OCCUPATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 occupational scholarship is sponsored by the Three Lakes Lions Foundation. This scholarship is intended for the student who wishes to prepare him/herself to enter a trade or occupation. Applicants should be aware that selection will not be made solely on the basis of class standing or GPA, but rather on real work objectives. This scholarship is available to all students of Three Lakes School District.

EAGLE RIVER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUXILIARY

Four \$1000 scholarships are available to any graduating senior (Northland Pines High School, Phelps High School or Three Lakes High School) for furthering their education in the medical field at a two or four year college of their choice, or a vocational/technical school. This scholarship is to be used within one year of the time it is presented for tuition. The Auxiliary's Scholarship Committee will select winners, and an interview may be required.

EAGLE RIVER ROTARY

The Eagle River Rotary is an organization of business and professional men and women united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all and help build goodwill and peace in the world. Their motto is.... SERVICE ABOVE SELF. Some areas of their focus is: Peace and Conflict Preventions/Resolution; Disease Prevention and Treatment; Water and Sanitation; Maternal and Child Health; Basic Education and Literacy; and Economic and Community Development. Their 4-way test of the things they think, say or do is: 1) Is it the TRUTH? 2) Is it FAIR to all concerned? 3) Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS? And 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned? The Eagle River Rotary is offering two \$1,000 scholarships to a graduate from Northland Pines or Three Lakes who will be attending either a four-year college or university or two-year community college technical school.

EDITH REITER TRUST SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient(s) must be a four-year graduating senior from Three Lakes High School. To qualify the applicant shall have a good academic record, and must intend to enroll in either a 2-year technical or 4-year college. This scholarship is \$500 a semester for up to eight semesters. There is a GPA requirement of 2.75 for continuation of this scholarship.

FATHER WILLIAM HORATH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to 1) any seniors who are members of St. Theresa or St. Kunegunda; 2) criteria based on service to the church and need; 3) this application requires a short essay entitled: "What my service to the church has taught me about my Catholic faith"; 4) Students can attend either a 2 or 4 year college or technical school. It does not have to be a Catholic school; 5) Zero to three \$1000 scholarships would be offered each year depending on the qualifications of the candidates

ROBERT AND LINDA FELLAND FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Robert and Linda Felland Foundation has established a civil engineering scholarship fund to benefit a qualified graduating senior from Three Lakes High School who displays a sincere interest in long-term environmental impacts of Civil Engineering on society. The scholarship is a four year commitment, and some of the criteria of the scholarship are as follows: 1) pursuit of a BS degree in civil engineering; 2) attendance at any public university in Wisconsin or any public university with shared tuition or reciprocity with Wisconsin; 3) setting a goal of graduating in four years and achieving that goal; 4) continuation of this scholarship for each consecutive semester is based upon maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for full time enrollment in each consecutive semester.

First Congregational United Church of Christ is offering different scholarships to seniors at Northland Pines High School, Phelps High School or Three Lakes High School. Applicants do not need to be a member of this church. GARBOWICZ-BOERS SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is intended to promote the study of Science. Amy Garbowicz and Aaron Boers are graduates of Three Lakes High School that pursued undergraduate and graduate Science degrees and have gone on to work in the fields of Geology and Environmental Science. They would like to encourage students to pursue their own studies in a field of Science (such as Biology, Environmental Science, Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics, etc.) One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Three Lakes High School pursuing a 4-year degree, with the intention to major in a field of Science.

HURVIS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is a four-year scholarship given from the Hurvis Family. The purpose of this scholarship is to aid and promote a student in any field for the pursuit of a four-year degree. The scholarship amount is \$1000. Any student with an interest in applying should meet the required criteria in the application.

DR. CAROL LAMON MEMORIAL

This \$500 scholarship is in memory of Dr. Carol Lamon. Dr. Lamon graduated from Three Lakes High School and went on to receive her undergraduate education degree from UW-Madison, obtain her Master's Degree from the University of MN and her Doctorate from the University of Colorado. She became a school psychologist after many years of teaching elementary and special education. This scholarship is open to graduating seniors from TLHS pursuing a degree in the field of special or general education. The criteria for the selection process will include the following: academic achievement, extra curricular activities, career goals, work history, character and integrity. The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant's institution, whereupon, half will be dispersed for the fall semester and the other half to be paid for the spring semester after recipient shows a GPA of at least a 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0).

ONEIDA TAVERN LEAGUE

This scholarship is open to any senior student preferably pursuing a degree in Hotel/Restaurant Management, Business, Culinary Arts, or any other related field; all students are encouraged to apply.

PHELPS MAPLE SYRUP FEST SCHOLARSHIP

The Phelps Maple Syrup Fest, an event sponsored by the Phelps Chamber of Commerce, will award a \$500 scholarship to one area student who will be continuing their education in the coming fall semester. Payment will be made directly to the school at the beginning of the second semester after confirmation of enrollment and proof of maintaining a 2.5 GPA has been received by the Phelps Maple Syrup Fest Committee. Consideration will be given to any area student who exhibits good study habits and a good work ethic and desires to continue his or her education. Academics, extra-curricular activity involvement, and community service will also be considered in selection.

The Three Lakes Red Suspenders Society Inc. is a non-profit organization composed of men and women volunteers, a charitable and education group that gives back to our community and surrounding areas. The Three Lakes Red Suspenders Committee will be offering two scholarships this year. The first will be in honor of Thomas Connelly, Three Lakes resident and Sergeant for the Langlade County Sheriff's Department to a student majoring in Police Science/Criminal Justice Field for \$500. The second will be in honor of Becky Moe, Three Lakes resident and RN, to a student majoring in Nursing or Medical Field for \$830.

Ripco Credit Union is providing a \$1000.00 scholarship to an outstanding graduating student who desires to further his/her education beyond high school. Criteria for the selection process will be 1) academic achievement; 2) career goals; 3) extra curricular activities; and 4) family affiliation with Ripco Credit Union.

The scholarship will be available directly to the student after successfully completing their first semester and providing proof of enrollment for the second semester. It must be used within a year of presentation. We extend our welcome to all applicants and recipients to join us at any of our meetings/functions to learn more about us and share their experiences.

SUGAR CAMP FIRE DEPARTMENT/MEDIC 11 VOLUNTEER SCHOLARSHIP

Sugar Camp Emergency Service Personnel are offering a scholarship to a senior at Three Lakes High School. The scholarship will be based upon volunteer services rendered to the school and community.

SUGAR CAMP/THREE LAKES LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships are available to any student graduating from Three Lakes High School. Scholarships will be awarded on the following criteria: grades, test scores, co-curricular activities, need, and application form information.

THREE LAKES-SUGAR CAMP LIONS CLUB COMBINATION SCHOLARSHIP

The amount is \$1000 to be distributed by the scholarship committee. Applicants may attend either college or vocational schools. Qualifications are to be weighed in the following order: Character, scholarship, citizenship, ambitions, dedication and desire, and need. No application needed, The Three Lakes and Sugar Camp Lions will chose one outstanding application from the applications submitted above.

THREE EAGLE CROSS COUNTRY/TRACK & FIELD SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to Three Lakes graduates that have participated for a minimum of one season on the track & field and/or cross country team for Three Lakes and plans to attend college and compete at the college level on a track or cross country team at that college. (Verification of enrollment required). The scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000 and will be paid out over the course of four years in the form of \$250 per year, pending involvement on the cross country and/or track team.

THREE LAKES AMERICAN LEGION POST 431 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Three Lakes American Legion Post 431 Memorial Scholarships (two) are awarded annually to the son, daughter, sibling, niece, nephew, or grandchild of veteran. The veteran need not be a member of the Legion. The recipients must be graduates of Three Lakes High School and planning to continue formal education equivalent to at least a one-year (two semesters) full-time course of instruction. Each scholarship totals \$2000, paid at the rate of \$1000 for each of two semesters, upon receipt of evidence of registration for each semester. An essay of 500 to 1500 words is required on "The Importance of Military Service in the Protection of America's Freedoms."

THREE LAKES COMMUNITY FOUNDATION – RISING STAR

The Three Lakes Community Foundation has created the Rising Star Scholarship in order to facilitate their mission of enhancing and supporting opportunities that make Three Lakes THE place to live, work, and play. This scholarship has been created to benefit a graduating student from the Three Lakes High School District who shows exceptional service to the community in the form of volunteer service. By awarding a scholarship of \$1000 to the student where the student would receive \$750 towards college tuition and \$250 that would be donated to a non-profit, 501@3 organization from the Three Lakes School District of the student's choice, we are inspiring community stewardship in our youth. Because of the volunteerism and philanthropy this student has given, this Three Lakes School District student will become the "Rising Star" of the community.

THREE LAKES THEATER COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1000 scholarship is available to those who are pursuing a career in the theater arts. This may include any aspect of theater including performance or technical.

THREE LAKES WATERFRONT ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The applicant may pursue a postsecondary education at either a four-year college or a two year technical school. An essay of approximately 1000 words on why you wish to pursue a career in the field of Natural Science and/or Environmental Sciences.

THREE LAKES FIRE DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The firefighters of Three Lakes Fire Department strongly encourage post-high school education for the young adults of the Three Lakes School District. The Department is offering a \$500 scholarship to a Three Lakes graduate entering a vocational or technical training program. The applicant will be selected on the basis of financial need, dedication toward learning, community service and character. The applicant will also write an essay of 200-300 words stating how this program will help them attain their goals. The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant's school to offset the cost of books, course fees, housing, etc.

THREE LAKES WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Applicant must have been accepted into an accredited college program. There are a multiple scholarships available, and is for female students. Applicants will be judged on the basis of scholarship, dedication, citizenship, character, personality, a 500-word essay, and a personal interview. The scholarship will be paid by the Women's Club directly to the college, upon written or verbal request from scholarship winner.

UNION CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF THREE LAKES SCHOLARSHIP

Union Congregational Church of Three Lakes will be offering a \$500 general college scholarship to a Three Lakes graduate.

UTILITY SOLUTIONS ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

Founded by a Three Lakes High School graduate, Utility Solutions is an engineering driven company which designs and manufactures innovative products for the electrical utility industry. The Utility Solutions Scholarship Fund was established as a means to say thank you and reinvest in the local community. This scholarship is an engineering discipline scholarship. The scholarship value is \$25,000 and designed to financially assist the selected student each semester over a 4-year period. The selected student must exhibit sincere interest in "hands-on" engineering along with a no quit attitude necessary to pursue this difficult college curriculum yet very rewarding career path.

WALTERS TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is in the amount of \$1800 and paid over two years for tuition at a technical school. Recipient must be accepted in an eligible Associate Degree Program at one of the Wisconsin Technical colleges. The application is attached hereto, along with a list of eligible programs.

CAROL YAHR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is in memory of Carol Yahr. Carol was a life-long educator who was a Friend of Education to the School District of Three Lakes. Carol's life was tragically taken in an auto accident at the hands of a young person who has a history of making poor decisions. The Yahr family is looking to reward a student who has made positive life choices and positive role model in their community. One \$1250 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Three Lakes High School pursuing a 2 or 4-year degree. The scholarship is \$625 per semester and is a renewable scholarship for up to 4 years. Continuation of scholarship is contingent upon students meeting the following criteria: must be enrolled full time at an accredited institution, maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, making progress toward graduation in the specific program, and complete a minimum of 12 credits per semester.

COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Applicant must have been accepted into an accredited college program leading to a degree in the mental health fields, such as: Psychiatric Nurse, Psychologist, Social Worker, Guidance and Counseling, etc. This scholarship is \$1000.

F. H. HIMES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To apply one must be planning a four-year education, or continue your education at a four-year college. The amount ranges from \$250 to \$500. Applicant must have completed actual arrangements for attendance in an accredited college or university.

HEADWATERS BUILDERS ASSOCIATION

Available to any graduate that will be going into a field related to the building trades. One \$250 scholarship is available.

JAYS NEST SCHOLARSHIP

The Jay's Nest Scholarship is given in honor of Sharon Phelps. The Jay's Nest was established from funds provided through a memorial fund for her grandchildren to use to meet the needs of people in their community. The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who is planning on attending a vocational or College program of study. A General Scholarship application form is required plus a statement/essay of 300-500 words, "How has adversity made you into a better person".

MBANK

Applicant must be planning on attending a 4-year univ. or 2-year tech. college in any field, a \$500 scholarship is available.

MASONIC LODGE - RHINELANDER and EAGLE RIVER

A \$500.00 general scholarship is open to all seniors who plan on learning a trade, or earn a technical degree.

NORTHWOODS INNOVATION will be giving out (2) \$1000 scholarships to (2) Three Lakes students who will be furthering their education at a Technical College pursuing a trade degree. (Welding, Fabrication, CAD or Electromechanical) The scholarship will be given out the 2nd semester of their college career. We will have the school allocate the funds. We are also requiring that the student Job Shadow at one of the Supporting Businesses of Northwoods Innovation.

JOSEPHINE MOTYLEWSKI SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of this scholarship is between \$200 and \$1000. Any student interested in applying should meet the following written criteria within the Three Lakes General Scholarship Application Form: 1) List the college planning to attend; 2) List field of endeavor; 3) Student must display commitment, desire, hard work and integrity; 4) Student must be average or above academically; 5) Student must have financial need.

R&S WINTER FAMILY FUND – VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL/TRADES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Robert and Sandra Winter spent their working lives in the mechanical contractors field with the August Winter & Sons Corporation in Appleton. They now reside in Eagle River in the summer months and Naples, Florida in the winter. Bob and Sandy have passions to support area high school graduates who want to pursue a career in the trades or technical fields. May apply for either the college or vocational-technical scholarship. Applicant must be admitted to a program beginning in the fall.

THREE LAKES ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

The Three Lakes Graduating Class of 1958 has set aside funds to award to a graduating senior from Three Lakes High School. Scholarship will be considered on the following criteria: attendance at Nicolet College, financial need, post-secondary plan, and academic achievement. Scholarship is \$1000 with \$500 being paid per semester based on program advancement. An attached essay will be required of 500 words or less on "What is your post secondary plan and how will this scholarship help you"
