

Three Lakes Lions Foundation ~ Don Burnside Occupational Scholarship

PURPOSE

The Three Lakes Lions Foundation is interested in encouraging local youth to enter the area's workforce and contribute to its economic health. To that end, they have approved an occupational scholarship of \$500 to be awarded annually to any Three Lakes High School graduate who intends to pursue a course of study leading to either a Certificate, Associate Degree or Apprenticeship, and enter directly into the area workforce upon its completion.

This scholarship is not intended for the student who will pursue a baccalaureate degree program or higher, but will prepare him/herself to enter a trade or occupation. Applicants should be aware that selection will not be made solely on the basis of class standing or GPA, but rather on real work objectives.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must complete the application form provided and include:

1. A Minimum of three letters of recommendation, with at least one from someone in his/her intended occupation.
2. A handwritten essay, on the back of the application including where he/she plans to attend classes, where he/she plans to live and/or work upon program completion. Applicant should also show their interest in their chosen field.
3. A complete job history showing where and when the job was held and the type of work done. Clarify is essential.

The Foundation believes that this may truly be called a "working person" program.
