GARBOWICZ-BOERS SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Description and statement of purpose:

This scholarship is inteded to promote the study of Science. Amy Garbowicz and Aaron Boers are graduates of Three Lakes School that pursued undergrauate and graduate Science degrees and have gone on to work in the fields of Geology and Environmental Science. They would like to encourage students to pursue their own studies in a field of Science (such as Biology, Environmental Science, Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics, etc.). One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Three Lakes High School pursuing a 4-year degree, with an intention to major in a field of Science.

Qualifications and criteria:

Senior graduation from Three Lakes High School Pursuing a 4-year degree in a field of Science

Recipient:

Selection of the candidate will be made by Amy Garbowicz and Aaron Boers and be based on the following criteria: program of study, academic achievement, essay response, recommendations, extra-curricular involvement, and community involvement.

Use of funds (sample):

Scholarship funds may be used for cost of education at any public or private college that has a qualifying 4-year degree program.

Alternate:

An alternate will be selected for the scholarship and only be eligible if the recipient does not attend a post secondary program.

Payment:

Disbursements will occur at the beginning of each semester with payment being made directly to the school the student is attending for a maximum of two (2) semesters. To receive payment students must submit a written request along with the course registration and grade reports.
