

## THE THREE LAKES WATERFRONT ASSOCIATION

The Three Lakes Waterfront Association scholarship is awarded annually to a graduate of Three Lakes High School. The recipient must be planning to continue formal education equivalent to at least a one-year (two semesters) full-time course of instruction in natural/environmental sciences or education in those fields. The scholarship totals \$1500, paid at the rate of \$750 for each of two semesters upon receipt of evidence of registration.

The final decision on the recipient will be made by the Three Lakes High School Scholarship Committee. Its decision will be based in part on an essay from each applicant judged by Three Lakes Waterfront Association Committee.

- A. Essay is to respond to the question "Why do you wish to pursue a career in the field of natural and/or environmental sciences?" (including education in these fields)
- B. Essay length is to be approximately 1000 words.
- C. Essay judging is to be based on quality and originality of thought, as well as the usual factors of spelling, grammar/syntax, punctuation, legibility, neatness, quotation credits, length, format, etc.
- D. Please attach the following: A list of extra-curricular activities, awards and honors, and your community involvement.
