Justin Szews Named Next Principal at Three Lakes Junior High/High School

Three Lakes, Wisconsin — Three Lakes School District is pleased to announce that Justin Szews has accepted the position of Three Lakes 7-12 principal beginning with the 2021-22 school year. Szews is currently the high school principal at Lakeland Union High School in Minoqua, Wis.

Szews received his undergraduate and master's degrees from UW-Stevens Point, where he also spent time as an assistant football coach. He graduated high school from Wittenberg-Birnamwood.

The Association of Wisconsin School Administrators named Szews Assistant Principal of the Year in 2018, and he was one of three finalists for the 2018 National Assistant Principal of the Year.

Maney stated that Szews has extensive training in educator professional development and instructional programming, which she believes will be especially important in a small school district like Three Lakes.

"Justin is active in our community and will be a familiar face to many who may not know him personally but will recognize him when they see him. We feel fortunate to have found the perfect person to fill the role of Three Lakes 7-12 principal."

"I am very excited for the new opportunity in the Three Lakes School District," Szews said.
