District Administrator Teri Maney Responds to DPI Reopening Guidelines

Three Lakes, Wisconsin — On Monday, June 22, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction released guidelines for schools to reopen for the 2020-21 school year. The document, which is titled "Education Forward," provides guidance for Wisconsin district and school leaders to use as they plan for a safe, efficient and equitable return to school amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

Three Lakes District Administrator Teri Maney would like to reassure parents and community members that the district will review the guidelines to create a reopening plan that is customized for TLSD.

"The DPI document contains many recommendations. However, it is our intention to apply it specifically to the needs of Three Lakes School District," Maney said. "We've already started planning for our back-to-school opening in Fall 2020. We want to reassure our community that every precaution will be in place to keep our kids safe at all times just as we would have done before the March 2020 closure.

"We want to remind you again that the DPI released guidelines, and we will be working directly with Oneida County Health Department prior to opening our doors on Sept. 1, 2020. We will be reviewing the document closely, and we will be in contact with our community throughout the summer as we plan for school reopening."

TLSD plans to share specific re-entry plans at the beginning of August. Parents will be notified through email alerts, and information will be posted to the district Facebook page and the district website.

"We'll have specifics about each topic within the document and how they relate specifically to Three Lakes," Maney said. "We look forward to our students walking through the doors of our school to start the 2020-21 school year."
