Actual amounts will be calculated and adjusted at the end of the year. Please monitor your child's account to have sufficient money for breakfast and lunch also. Prices as follows:

- Snack milk - \$.25 (Free if receiving free or reduced lunch)
- Breakfast - \$1.35 (\$.30 reduced)
- Lunch - \$2.75 (\$.40 reduced)
