Three Lakes District Responds to Non-Specific Threat

Three Lakes, Wisconsin — The purpose of this communication is to follow up on the incident that was reported to law enforcement at approximately 7 p.m. on Tuesday, May 28. The report being a non-specific threat in the form of graffiti within the school. Three Lakes Police Dept., along with school officials, then conducted locker searches and determined that there was not a viable threat to the students and staff of the Three Lakes School District.

However, out of the utmost caution for our staff and students, we will be under a lockout today, Wednesday, May 29, which means all outside doors will be secured and no one will be allowed to come in or out until screened and/or the lockout is lifted. Classes will continue as usual. Also, bag searches will be performed this morning as students enter the building. We will also have a police presence in the building today.

Student safety is our No. 1 priority, and we take it very seriously. We appreciate your patience as we work on investigating this situation. We'll continue to update you as new information becomes available.
