



What makes students college ready, career ready and life ready? The answer is complex because we know students are more than a test score or a set of numbers. Here are a few indicators that our students are prepared for life beyond the classroom ... wherever it might take them.

ATTENDANCE RATE

Less than 10 percent absenteeism is a predictor of post-secondary success.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities give students an opportunity to be active in their communities and to take their learning beyond the classrom. Students who particpate in co-curriculars do better academically and are better prepared for the next stages of life.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Career and Technical (CTE) classes provide quality work-based learning programs, relevant academic skills and workforce behaviors necessary for success. These courses can include culinary arts, accounting, welding, building trades and more.

COLLEGE-READY INDICATORS

Standardized testing has traditionally been used as the primary college readiness indicator, but schools now recognize student success is more complex. Experts around the country are "redefining ready" to include data markers such as Algebra II grades, GPA, attendance and more. Here's a look at TLHS data in a few of these areas.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

High school grade point average is consistently the strongest predictor of 4-year college outcomes. Studies show that students with a 2.8 or higher show increased success.
