Great Lakes Great Apple Crunch

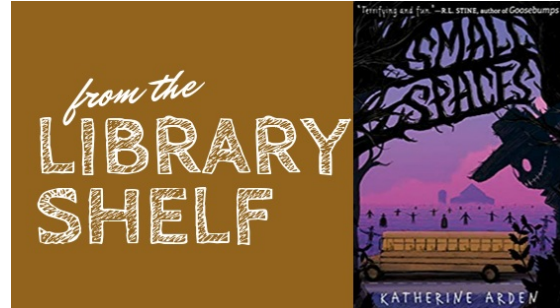
CRUNCH! Don't you just love biting into a fall
