1. Call to Order – Kira B.

2. Review of December minutes – approved by Heather, Ann seconds.
 - Discussion re: Lakeshore photography and how they donate agendas to the school. Parents & teachers express discontent at how photos turned out. Kira will contact Steve G. to have addressed at the staff meeting.
 - STEM (STEAM) Lowe’s grant – Heidi R., Mrs. Garbowicz to follow up. Science, Technology, Engineering (Art) & Math grant would potentially offer a space for elementary students to experiment in these sciences. Dianna Blicharz & Marilynn Garbowicz to draft a vision of what this space would look like and bring to February meeting!
3. Treasurer’s Report – Heather B.
 - \$276 out in December; \$1,060 in. Essentially broke even after money spent in November on Santa’s Secret Shop. Ending balance \$7,988.29
 - Funding request –Charlie Volk requesting 4-6th grade ski trip \$200. Concern raised that all grades may not go, is trip approved yet? Tabled for now until discussed further.
